Indonesia has hosted the Asian Games twice (1962, 2018), the Asian Para Games (2018), the FIFA U-17 World Cup (2023), the FIBA Basketball World Cup (2023, co-host), the World Artistic Gymnastics Championships (2025, the first in Southeast Asia), the AFC Futsal Asian Cup (2026), MotoGP every year since 2022, WorldSBK (2021 to 2023), Formula E (2022, 2023, 2025) and the FIH2O world championship at Lake Toba (2023 to 2025). The Indonesia Open has been a fixture of world badminton since 1982.

One door into government

Who does what

- **Kemenpora** (Kementerian Pemuda dan Olahraga): the Deputi Bidang Pengembangan Industri Olahraga is your first contact; the Deputi Bidang Peningkatan Prestasi Olahraga works with federations on championships.
- **Induk organisasi cabang olahraga** (the national federation for the sport): co-organizes and recommends international championships under UU 11/2022 and PP 46/2024.
- **Kemenpar** (Kementerian Pariwisata): the Deputi Bidang Produk Wisata dan Penyelenggara Kegiatan runs Karisma Event Nusantara, which curates and promotes 125 events a year.
- **KOI** (Komite Olimpiade Indonesia): Olympic-movement events and multi-sport games.
- **Pemerintah provinsi or kabupaten/kota** and its Dispora: venues, security, local permits.
- **Polri**: izin keramaian (event permit). **Ditjen Imigrasi**: C8 and C5 visas. **Bea Cukai** and **Kadin Indonesia**: ATA Carnet and temporary admission.

What the ministry provides

- A single point of contact that convenes all of the above
- Guidance through the federation recommendation, Kemenpora approval and the Polri izin keramaian
- Visa facilitation: C8 for athletes and officials (60 days, extendable, lodged by the Indonesian host as guarantor on evisa.imigrasi.go.id); C5 for media with an organizer's letter
- Equipment: ATA Carnet (Kadin Indonesia) or Bea Cukai impor sementara with duty exemption on re-export (PMK 178/2017 as amended)
- Promotion: Indonesia Sport Calendar listing, Karisma Event Nusantara curation where eligible
- Co-funding discussed case by case through the national federation for world-level championships (as for the 2025 world championships in climbing, surfing and gymnastics). There is no open grant scheme.

What we ask of an event

Eligibility

- Sanctioned or endorsed by the international federation or continental confederation
- Staged in partnership with the Indonesian national federation
- Participants from at least three countries, or a mass-participation event with meaningful international entry
- Enquiry 9 to 12 months before a championship; 3 months before a calendar-only listing
- A named entity able to act as Indonesian guarantor for visas and permits, or a partner that will

Sponsorship and compliance

- **Tobacco:** branded sponsorship of media-covered events and tobacco products at public sports events are prohibited (Health Regulation PP 28/2024)
- **Betting and gambling:** illegal; no betting sponsorship or branding
- **Alcohol:** no broadcast advertising; promotion restricted (Perpres 74/2013)
- **Polri izin keramaian:** statement of the organizer, recommendation of the competent authority, and for foreign entrants a participant list with passport and visa details
- **Media:** foreign journalists and crews enter on the C5 visa, not a tourist entry
